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SİLİFKE REGION



Due to the lack of modern tools and the effect of social, economic and historical conditions, people of silifke met most of their clothing needs with their own labor by weaving and sewing

AFYON REGION

Men's folk dances in Afyon reflect a unity that continues the tradition of Efe, Zeybek, Kızan and Seğmen, which is the same in every region of the province. Clothing has also followed suit.



MUĞLA REGION



The clothing styles seen/used in Muğla Center, Köyceğiz, Ula and Yatağan are also valid for Milas. These clothes; It is examined in three parts as head, body and foot wear.

BITLİS REGION

Although there is a transition to new clothing styles in urban centers, traditional clothing continues to exist in rural areas. Men who have frequent relations with the city have adopted wearing caps, jackets and trousers. Almost all of the children wear gowns until they are 4 or 5 years old.
