The title means "Flowers, flowers" in Italian; depending on the dialects, the word "çiuri" can also become "sciuri".. When we talk about Sciuri Sciuri, we refer to a cheerful melody, which makes you want to dance. The Sicilian musical repertoire is a set of traditions, customs and traditions. An interweaving of serenades, stornelli and polyvocal songs. Sicilian music tells a people and softens the feelings. It describes everyday life and becomes a sweet pretext for a wider search, to find and rediscover our roots and the relics of an often forgotten past.. The song has been performed by several artists over time. Fiorello, but also by Roy Paci, Gabriella Ferri and Luisa De Santis with a reworking entitled Sciuri Sciuri.
